New transformer to Richmond Terminal Station

SP AusNet delivered a new 132 tonne transformer from Glen Waverley to its Richmond Terminal Station site early yesterday morning as part of improving reliability of electricity supply to customers.

The transformer is part of works, undertaken on behalf of CitiPower and United Energy Distribution, the owners and operators of the electricity distribution networks supplied from SP AusNet's Richmond Terminal Station.

Kerry Karafotias, SP AusNet's Manager, Program Delivery, thanked all those involved in the safe delivery of the transformer, particularly the local community.

"The coordination has been extensive, involving many stakeholders," Mr Karafotias said.

"SP AusNet would specifically like to thank the local community for working with us to safely deliver this essential piece of equipment that will be used to enhance the reliable delivery of electricity to CitiPower's and United Energy's customers," he said.

SP AusNet will be upgrading the entire Richmond Terminal Station over the next five years to improve reliability for the 118,000 residential and business customers supplied from the station.
